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INSTRUCTIONS

Form W-222, *Statement of Minnesota Residency*, should be completed by Minnesota residents who had Wisconsin income tax withheld from Wisconsin wages and are filing a Wisconsin income tax return (Form 1NPR) to claim a refund of the Wisconsin income tax withheld for 2009 or prior years.

Resident – For income tax purposes, legal resident, resident, residency, and domicile are synonymous. Residency is defined as a person's true, fixed, and permanent home where a person intends to remain permanently and indefinitely and to which, whenever absent, a person has the intention of returning. If you are unsure of your resident status, contact the department at the phone number listed at the top of the form.

Fill in the year to which this form applies. For example, if you are filing a 2009 Form 1NPR to claim a refund for tax withheld during 2009, fill in 2009 in the calendar year space.

Fill in all of the requested information. Because this form is to be used only by Minnesota residents, if the address you fill in is not a Minnesota address, attach an explanation of why it is not a Minnesota address.

Sign and date the form. Attach the form to your Wisconsin Form 1NPR.
